### National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs For the 2019-2020 School Year

Dear Parent or Guardian:

McMinnville School District will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for Columbus, Buel, Grandhaven, Newby, and Wascher elementary students for the 2019-2020 school year. The Food and Nutrition Service of the United States Department of Agriculture administers this program and provides funding.

Students attending Columbus, Buel, Grandhaven, Newby, and Wascher elementary are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch including milk at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2019-2020 school year. No further action is required of you. Your elementary child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

Students will still be able to purchase milk or juice to accompany meals brought from home for .60 cents if desired. Additional breakfasts or lunches will be available for purchase if desired. The prices are listed below.

Students attending Memorial Elementary, Patton Middle School, Duniway Middle School, and McMinnville High School will receive meals through the traditional National School Lunch Program. This means that students who are not approved for free or reduced meal benefits will be required to pay for meals. We encourage all families needing meal benefits to apply. After October 16, 2019, those families approved for benefits last year will be required to have new benefit approvals for this school year. The income guidelines change each year, so families are required to apply each school year under the traditional program. If families are not approved by the October 16, 2019 deadline, they will be required to pay the full meal price. The previous status of your student (eligible or ineligible for free/reduced meals) will be retained through the October deadline unless a new application is received. New benefit status takes effect immediately upon application processing.

There are two ways you may apply for free/reduced meals:

1. *\*Complete an application on line\**~To access the online application go to the MSD website: [www.msd.k12.or.us](http://www.msd.k12.or.us). Click on 'departments' on the gray banner near the top of the page. Then, select Nutrition Services. A blue box will appear to the right. Click on Free and Reduced Meal/Fees. Once the application is complete, you can submit the application online.
2. *\*Complete a paper application\**~ you may pick one up at your student's school. Once complete, return the application to your student's school, or mail it to or drop it off at McMinnville School District District Office, 800 NE Lafayette, Ave., McMinnville, Oregon. 97128.
